

And currently attending pre-school at Mary Ward Preschool.














## How I got involved in this work

## THE MAGNITUDE OF THE PROBLEMS

- **During the 2022/23, more than 7.7 million people, faced food insecurity.**
- **About 3.5 million children suffer from chronic hunger.**

**Over 67% of Zimbabwe's school children do not have access to Education** 

- **42%** of Zimbabwe's population lives in extreme poverty
- **26.7%** of children have stunted growth

- **\$ 95%** of the population is unemployed
- **\$16,3** million people in Zimbabwe

With approximately 74% of the population living on less than \$5.50 a day



## The situation for poor children is deeply disturbing

- **❖ 4.8 million** children <u>live in poverty</u>, with **1.6 million** of them <u>facing extreme poverty</u>.
- \* The most pressing issues for poor children include <u>malnutrition</u>, <u>education</u>, <u>health</u>, <u>sanitation</u>, <u>and access to clean water</u>.
- **❖ No access to education,** they have **no school fees, uniforms, and textbooks.**
- \* Malaria affecting children under five.

#### HOW THE CJS ARE MAKING AN IMPACT WITH YOUR DONATION

- **❖Junior's story** is one of the **62 children at Mary Ward Children's Home** where your donation feed, educate, clothe, give shelter and medication, etc.
- **❖** Your donation saved lives, about 64,800 patients received health services at our clinics St Joseph clinic, Chishawasha and St Padre Pio Poly Clinic in Norton
- ❖ Your huge donation for the building of Mary Ward High School have impacted 510 direct Beneficials and 2 000 indirect Beneficials
- This past year, we have impacted about 1 800 pupils through education.

- ❖Through your donation, we were able to feed 320 students at Nesigwe Secondary School for the whole year people.














## Our goal/vision

This year the need has grown because of the severe drought that has devastated our communities, leaving families without access to clean water, food, and basic needs.

- ❖ Our vision is to see 100% of the poor people have access to clean water
- ❖ Our vision is to see 100% of our institutions have access to solar power
- ❖ Our goal is to continue feeding, clothing, educating **62 children at Mary** Ward Children's Home.
- ❖ We envision a High School where learners have access to a library



- ❖ Our vision is to build a 3<sup>rd</sup> block for form 5 and 6 at Mary Ward High School
- ❖ Our vision is to see 100% of the poor people have access to health services
- Our vision is to purchase a small bus to transport our children to and from school every day.
- ❖ Our vision is to end hunger for all **320** students at Nesigwe Secondary School
- Our goal is to end illiteracy among the poorest people
